Requirements

Pipe Band

Band	5 pipers, 2 snare drummers and 1 bass are required; 1 March Medley of tunes, played in quick time, 2 minutes 45 seconds to 4 minutes 30 seconds duration. In addition, a non-juvenile piper as Pipe Major and a non-juvenile drummer as Drum Sergeant (Lead Tip) may be added. Adult players are not counted for to meet the minimum requirements
Quartet	4 pipers; own choice medley 2 minutes 45 seconds to 4 minutes 30 seconds duration.
Trio	2 pipers and 1 snare drummer; own choice medley 2 minutes 45 seconds to 4 minutes 30 seconds duration.

All competitors must be 18 years of age and under unless stated.

Submit and play 1 two-parted March of any time signature, once over. Must never have competed in a piping contest.	Submit and play 1 four-parted 2/4 March, once over.	Submit and play 1 two-parted March of any time signature, once over.

Practice Pad	Snare Drumming	
	Division A	Division B
Play a series of rudiments including: the long roll (double stroke roll), five and nine stroke open rolls, paradiddles, and a continuous closed roll. The rudiments are to be played starting slowly with a gradual accelerando and stopping when a limit of competency is attained.	Submit one (1) four-parted 2/4 March.	Submit one (1) two-parted 2/4 March.
